Completion of the Social Work program is designed to result in an Associate of Arts degree and meets the general-education requirements at all Idaho public universities. Graduates will be prepared to transfer to Idaho public institutions with a greater understanding of generalist social work practice and how to practice at a diversity-competent level. Ideally, course selection should be coordinated to meet requirements for your intended transfer institution. Students with a Bachelor's degree in Social Work often pursue careers in various areas of helping including addiction, crisis intervention, case management, child/youth services, disability services, geriatrics, homelessness/housing, psychiatric or mental-health care, childcare, rehabilitation, and social-welfare worker.
